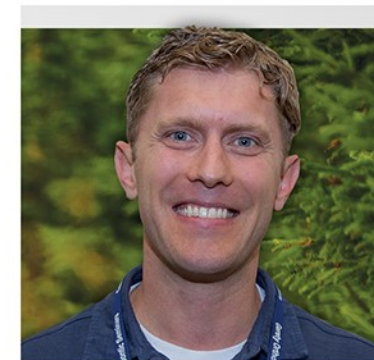


Dr. Debra Ettle-Resnick – Senior Instructor
