

ABOUT THE BASIC ASSISTANT COURSE

Each year Robin Schmidbauer offers a Basic Assistants course for the dental auxiliary. The course is taught on a beginning level and is geared for assistants, hygienists and associates who are new to orthodontics and/or the Straight Wire Technique.

This 2 day course is approved for 13 hours of continuing education. Students are encouraged to join doctors Sunday to see actual cases diagnosed, treated and evaluated.

This program is a perfect complement to offices utilizing Dr. Robert Gerety's technique. However, Robin's knowledge of orthodontics in the general practitioner's office and experience as a clinician means she has valuable insight for any assistant. More importantly she communicates them well. Whether you are a former student of Dr. Bob Gerety, Dr. Joe Schmidbauer, or use another protocol, this course will make your staff more productive in your practice.



The two-day basic course cost is \$595 and includes a course manual and the materials necessary to complete the hands-on projects. A complete list of instruments required for project participation will be provided at registration.

BASIC ASSISTANT COURSE OUTLINE

- > Take quality records that will assist the dentist in proper diagnosis, treatment planning and case presentation during patient consultation
- > Trace a cephalometric x-ray by hand or digitally
- Identify orthodontic pliers, wires and utilities used in orthodontic treatment.
- Place brackets in the proper height and position
- Place spacers, bands, wires and ligatures
- Wire sequence for the Straight Wire Technique
- Have a complete understanding of the straight wire technique to better assist their doctor with all orthodontic procedures
- > Instruction on instrument and auxiliary preparation for the doctor's needs for each individual patient appointment

ABOUT THE ADVANCED ASSISTANT COURSE

Although it is not mandatory that you participate in the Basic Assistant course, this course is specifically structured for staff personnel who have previously taken any basic assistant course. It is designed to meet the needs of the doctor and assistants who are currently utilizing Straight Wire mechanics and would like to expand the delegable duties to be performed. This is not a beginning course! This program is an excellent follow-up for assistants who have previously participated in Straight Wire courses or have extensive experience in orthodontic assisting.

It is recommended that participants be familiar with cephalometric tracing, ligation methods and general monthly maintenance procedures. Each assistant needs to be comfortable with basic orthodontic procedures.

This 2 day course is approved for 13 hours of continuing education.



- > Understanding cephalometric skeletal and dental classifications and discrepancies
- > Treatment options
- > The straight-wire philosophy and how it pertains to bracket placement, tip and torque, level, align, rotate, and forces
- > Archwire sequence and auxiliary forces
- > Participation exercises include:
 - > Wax bite registration and archwire coordination
 - Accentuating curve
 - Omega cinch backs
 - Open coil spring and power chain
 - > Step in and out bends
 - Ligation methods for activation

- > MDA adaptation, placement, and activation
- Cuspid retraction
- Individual root torque
- Pletcher springs to posted wire (de-torquing rectangular archwire)
- > Bonded lower lingual retainer



PREREQUISITE

Participants should be familiar with basic orthodontic records, bracket and band placement, ligation methods, and basic wire-changing techniques.
